Our Program

Lanzando Líderes (Launching Leaders) is a community-based, afterschool youth leadership program for Latino high school students. Our program is culturally-grounded and founded on the principles of social equity and social determinants of health. As a partner of *Puentes de Salud*, we work collaboratively and consistently with the South Philadelphia Latino community to sustain an afterschool program that meets the needs of students and their families. We believe that each student has a unique *camino* (path) to explore and pursue. Our program supports students in their development as young leaders by fostering cultural pride and identity, building knowledge and skills, and promoting personal wellbeing.

Your Role

As a **Tutor-Mentor Intern (TMI)**, your knowledge, skills, and passion will help facilitate rich, engaging, and meaningful experiences with our students. TMIs work as tutors, college mentors, and workshop collaborators to create and sustain a community that nurtures students' daily learning experiences and long-term growth by:

- Meeting students' academic needs and increasing learning and comprehension of school curricula.
- Fostering leadership abilities and encouraging students to explore their personal, college, and career ambitions.
- Engaging students' curiosity and building knowledge about the college process and student life.

Eligibility & Commitment

We seek highly-motivated, engaging, and committed applicants who possess the dynamic skills and enthusiasm to work with Latino youth in South Philadelphia. We encourage all current undergraduates, graduate students, and recent college graduates (within 3 years of graduation) to apply for this internship! Spanish proficiency is helpful, but not required. All applicants should be able to fulfill the following TMI responsibilities:

- Submit a complete Tutor-Mentor Intern Application by **Monday, September 4th, 2017**.
- Attend a brief meeting with a *Lanzando Líderes* coordinator prior to the start of the program.
- Complete the online PA Child Abuse Certification Form and FBI Criminal Background Check clearances by **Friday, September 15th, 2017**.
- Attend a mandatory on-site TMI training from **9 AM - 12 PM on Saturday, September 16th, 2017**.
- Commit to attending *Lanzando Líderes* one consistent day per week, **Monday-Thursday, from 3:30 PM - 6:00 PM** for a full 10-week program semester, with the exception of holidays and academic breaks. Programming for Fall 2017 begins on **September 25th, 2017** and concludes on **December 7th, 2017**.
